

CITY OF COQUITLAM

BYLAW NO. 2699, 1993

A bylaw to authorize the dedication
of certain land as Urban Forest Park

WHEREAS there is strong public interest in the formal dedication as Urban Forest Park certain lands held by the City of Coquitlam for park purposes:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Coquitlam in open meeting assembled **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. For the purpose of this bylaw urban forest park means:

"A large tract of wooded land located within a populous community, dedicated for the public's use and enjoyment and to the management, conservation and enhancement of the native flora and fauna."

2. This dedication will permit forest and lake management, the construction of such things as trails, picnic areas, washrooms, nature houses, boardwalks, docks, parking areas and related passive recreation amenities to accommodate those individuals using the urban forest park.

3. The following lands, owned by the City of Coquitlam and held for park are hereby dedicated as urban forest park:

- a) the forested portions of Mundy Park and;
- b) Riverview Forest,

as outlined on Schedule A to this bylaw (the lands).

4. The City of Coquitlam maintains its right to enter upon and to have free and uninterrupted access to any portion or portions of the lands, or any of them for the purpose of undertaking forest fire protection measures and for the purpose of installing, repairing, clearing and maintaining any public utilities or public works without limiting the generality of the foregoing now or hereafter installed upon any of the hereinbefore described lands.

The City specifically maintains the right to widen and improve Como Lake Avenue and Mariner Way and construct any other road works deemed necessary by the City within the lands.

5. The Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized and empowered to sign any documents required by and to do any acts necessary and incident to the carrying out of this Bylaw.
6. This Bylaw may be cited as the "City of Coquitlam Riverview Forest and Mundy Park Urban Forest Park Dedication Bylaw No. 2699, 1993."

READ A FIRST TIME this 18 day of October 1993.

READ A SECOND TIME this 18 day of October 1993.

READ A THIRD TIME this 18 day of October 1993.

RECEIVED the assent of the electors on the 20th day of November, 1993.


RECONSIDERED, FINALLY PASSED AND ADOPTED, and the Seal of the City of Coquitlam affixed this 7th day of December, 1993.
